The late return form (can be found on the school website) is to be completed for any student(s) who expects to return to school LATER THAN 12:00 pm Wednesday, Sep. 6, 2023. Please complete this form and return to the school principal before ASAP. If a student is not returning on or before September 13, 2023, a school cannot reserve a spot guaranteeing the ability to be enrolled in the school. There may be a need for placement at another school upon the students' late return.

In the event of an unforeseen critical family circumstance occurring on or after July 1, 2023, that causes an unexpected late return to the school, the parent must advise the school as soon as possible by email via the school website or by letter directed to the Principal.

TIMETABLE STRUCTURE FOR 2023-24

The Hugh Boyd Timetable Structure for 2023-24 will remain the same as it was this year. *Finally, the students have a chance to get accustomed to something!* Boyd will be using a **Semester model** (4 classes for half the year, then 4 new courses in the second half). Start and end times remain 8:30 AM and 3:00 PM with 10 minutes between classes and a 45-minute lunch. Personalized Learning Time will return to Boyd, offered from 8:30-9:25 AM on Tuesdays and Thursdays, where students can get additional help from the teacher(s) of their choice.
