The Gaming Grant amount was \$12,240 and there was also \$500 left over from last years Wishlist because a guest speaker had to be cancelled due to Covid. As well, last year After Grad Committee was approved funds of \$2,950 of which \$2,640.44 were already used as a deposit for the event which was cancelled. This paid deposit is available to be used towards this year event minus a \$100 admin fee. Thus, the After Grad Committee already have \$2,540.44 in funds (deposit) plus the balance funds of \$309.56 available to help fund the event this year if able to proceed.

Note: Due to Covid 19 creating so many shutdowns, the funds for a Gaming Grant may or may not be available next year. So the PAC and members felt it important to put aside approximately \$6,000 for next year incase we do not receive a Gaming Grant.

Principle's Report

Since our last PAC meeting, we have had a number of great things happening at Boyd:

-Remembrance Day video commemorating the 75th anniversary of the end of WWII as well as recognizing experiences of diverse communities – video would not have been possible without the support of Student Council (Mr. Mamonluk) as well as students from the Video Production (Mr. Chan), drama (Mr. MacDonald), Arts (Ms. Moss) and music (Mr. Naso) programs. Our librarian Ms. Leung made significant contributions as well.

-Dancing Water Sandy – Indigenous educator that presented to First Nations students and gave a lesson on creating beaded medicine bags

-a number of extra-curriculars have been up and running in the past month – Student Council, GLOW, Interact, First Responders, eSports, Grad Committee, Library Monitors, Band, Volleyball (with recent health orders, is now on pause)

-Extended Learning Time will be starting in the coming days – students who sign-up can get additional academic support on specified days after school in the library

-Grade 8 Activity Days occurring over the next week and a half – will be very different than what normally occurs, however, wanted to provide an opportunity to connect with Grade 8s outside of the classroom setting

-Hugh Boyd shop – Boyd swag will be available for purchase in the new year; is currently a 'design your own hoodie' competition – winning entry will be a part of the HB Shop

-Boyd's seismic upgrade and renovation is for complete for the most part.

-Health and Safety is a continued point of emphasis with students and staff.

-November 26 is Quarter 2 Meet the Teacher – parents will be hearing from teachers in one of three ways (email, Zoom/Teams call, or video link)

-Quarter 1 Report Cards will be published on November 27
