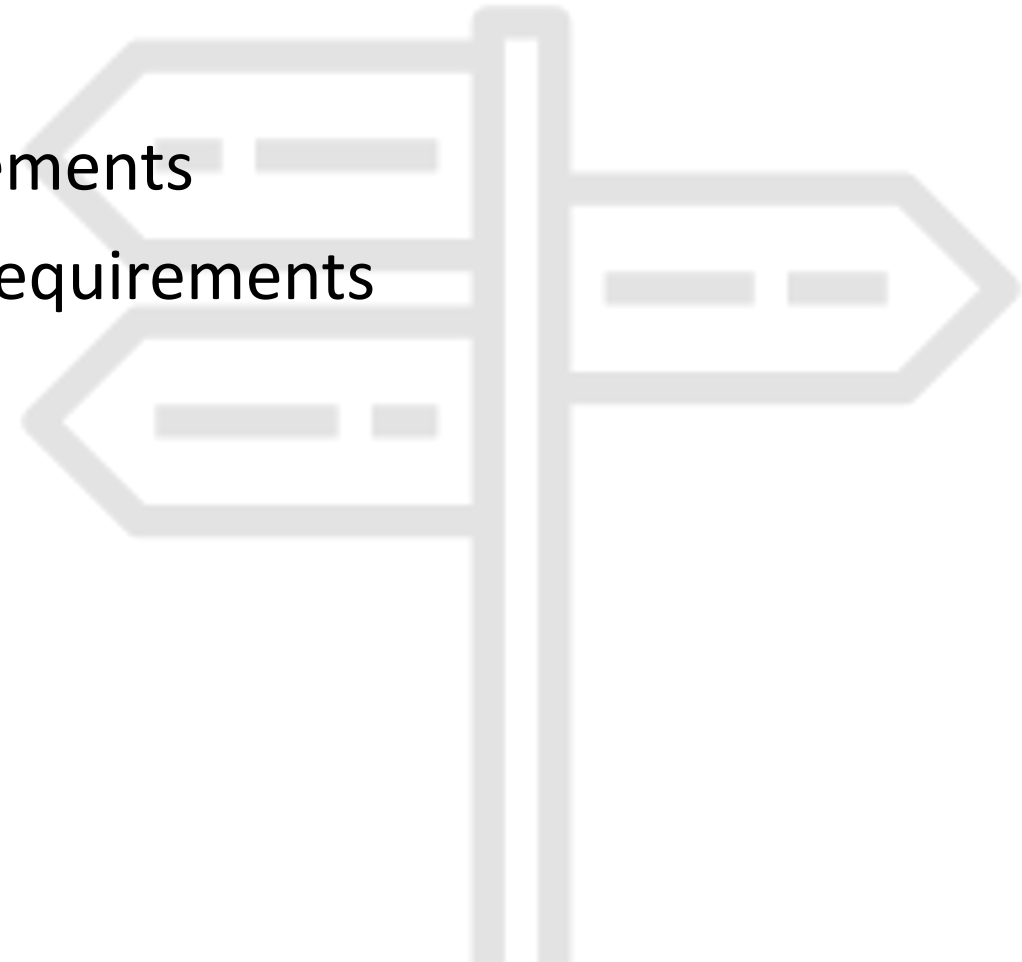

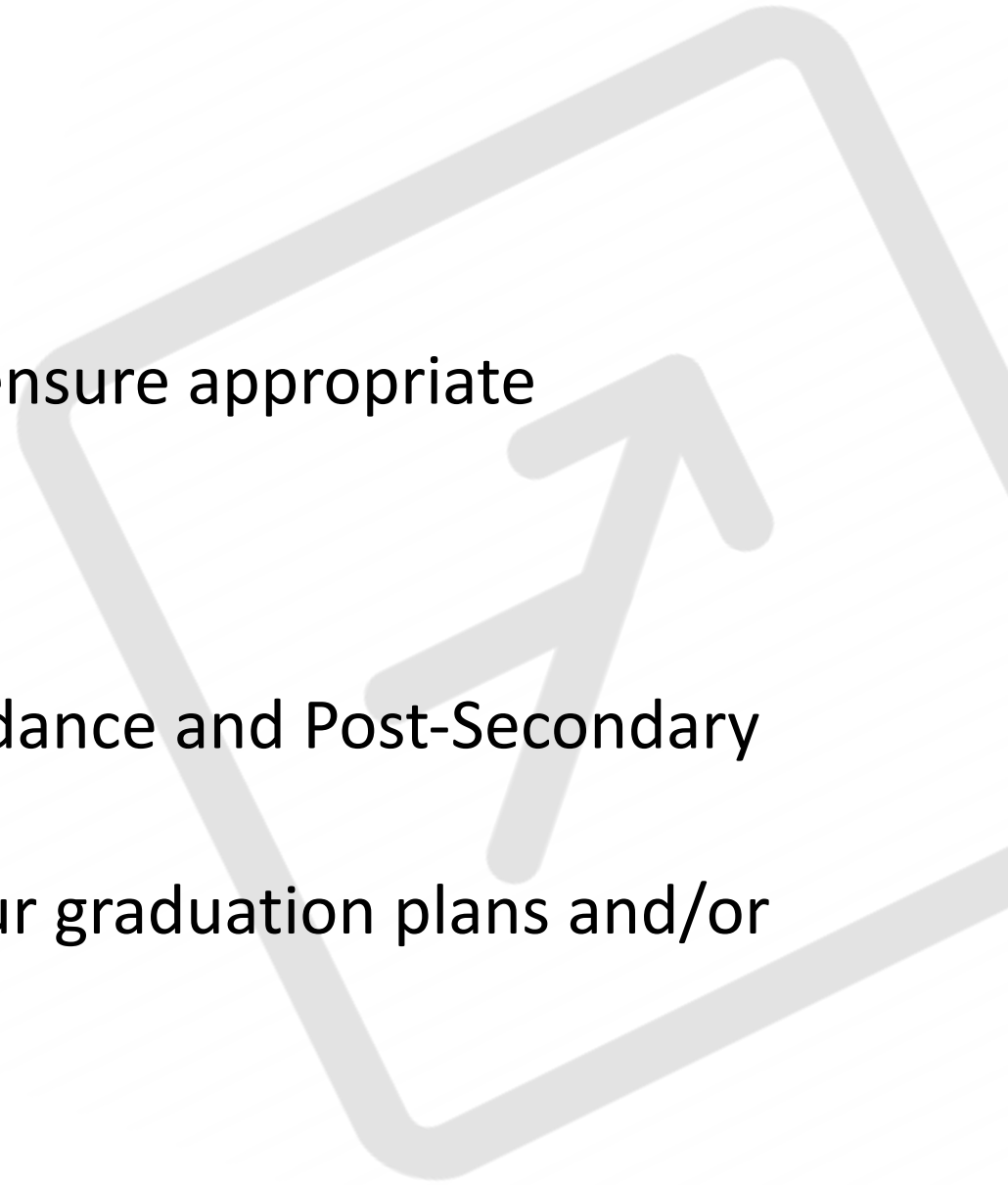

# OUR ROLE

- To complete graduation credit reviews to ensure appropriate graduation. These are based on:
  1. Meeting requirements
  2. Your Graduation Plan
- Assist in connecting you to our Career Guidance and Post-Secondary advisor, Ms. Jones
- Review, with your teachers, updates to your graduation plans and/or courses as they fit your graduation plan



# YOUR ROLE

- Research a career and/or post-secondary education plan that interests you
- Determine the job and/or admissions requirements for a career and/or post-secondary education plan that interests you
- Communicate your course needs with teachers and counsellors
- Identify, with counsellor and teacher support, which graduation plan allows you to pursue your interest
- Review your credit reviews that your counsellor generated and ensure it is current, as well as reflective of your plans
- Communicate any issues with your courses and how they may impact your plan to teachers and counsellors

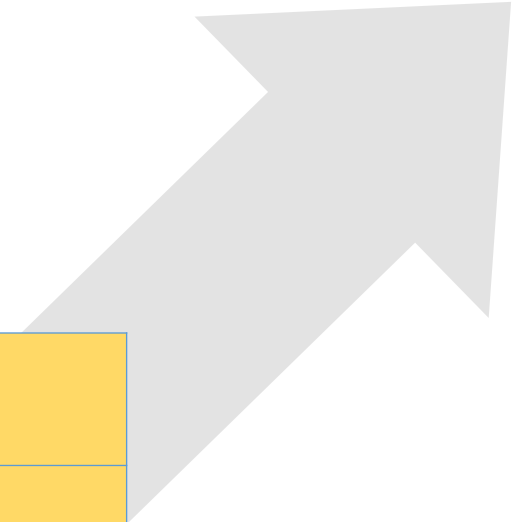

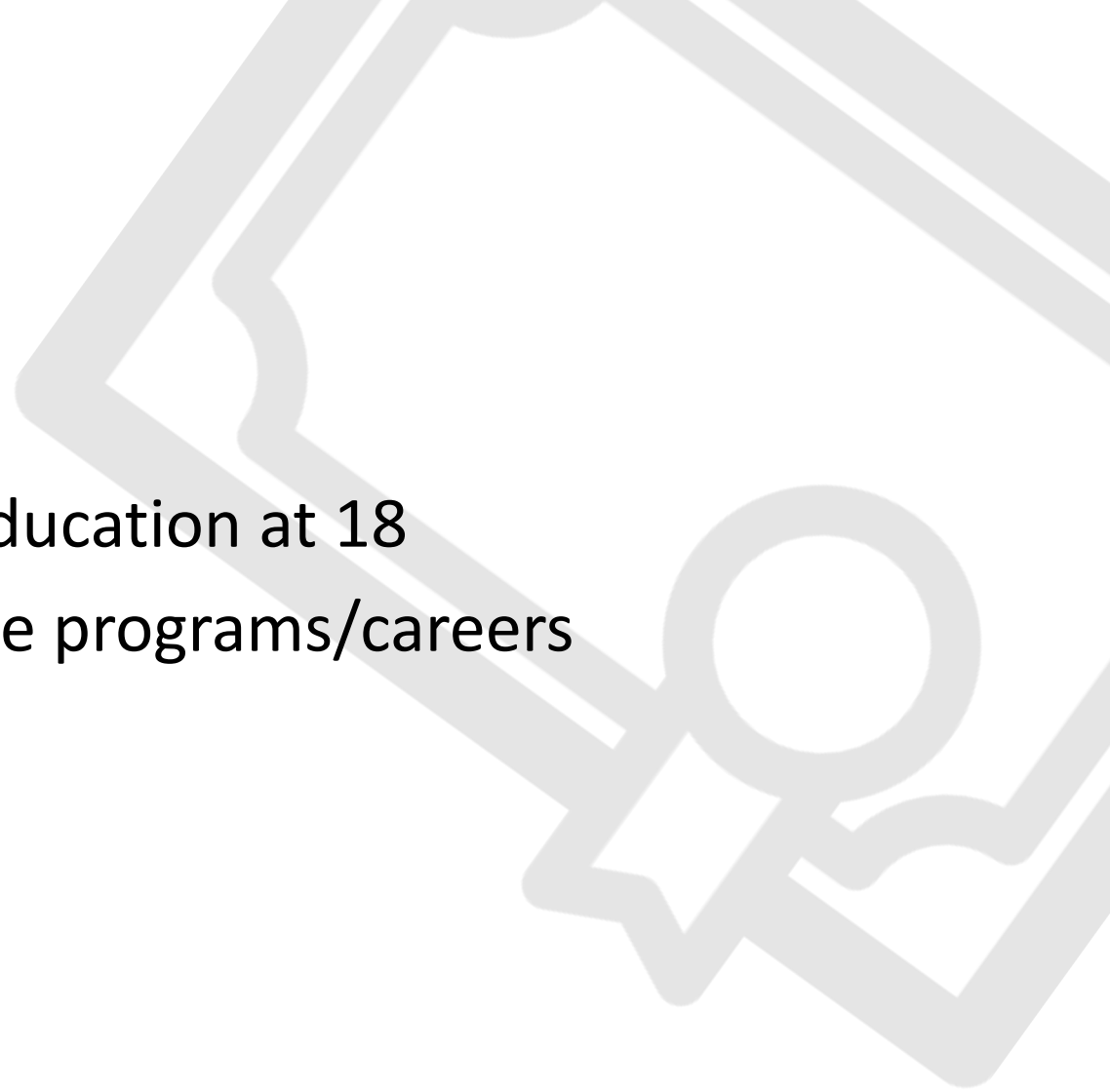

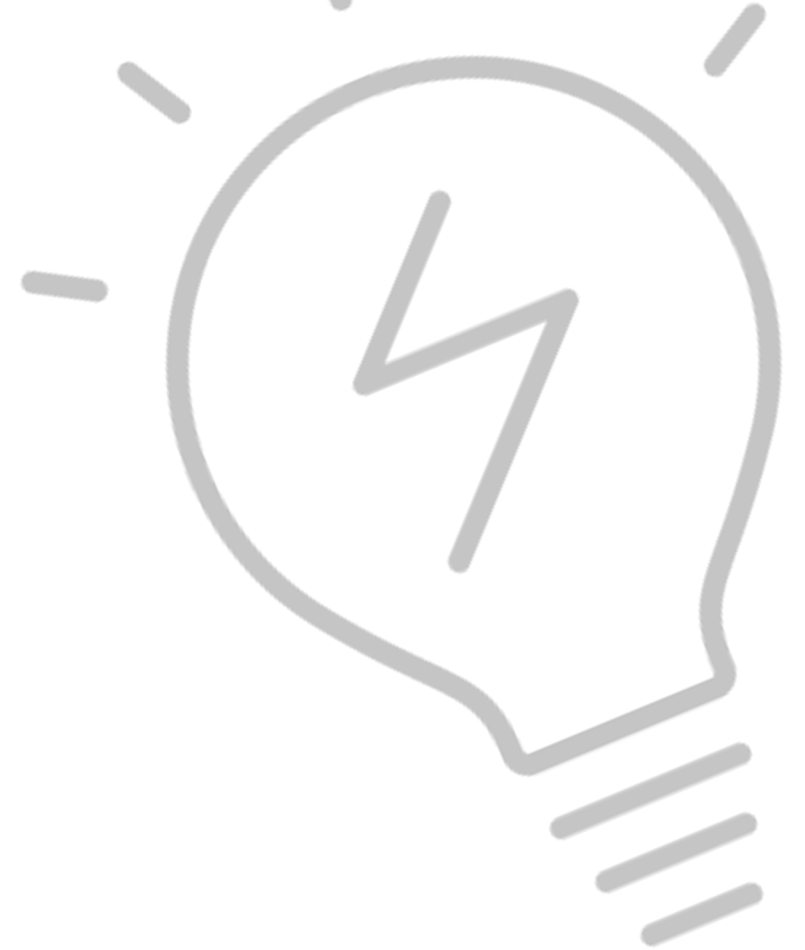
## WHY THIS PLAN?

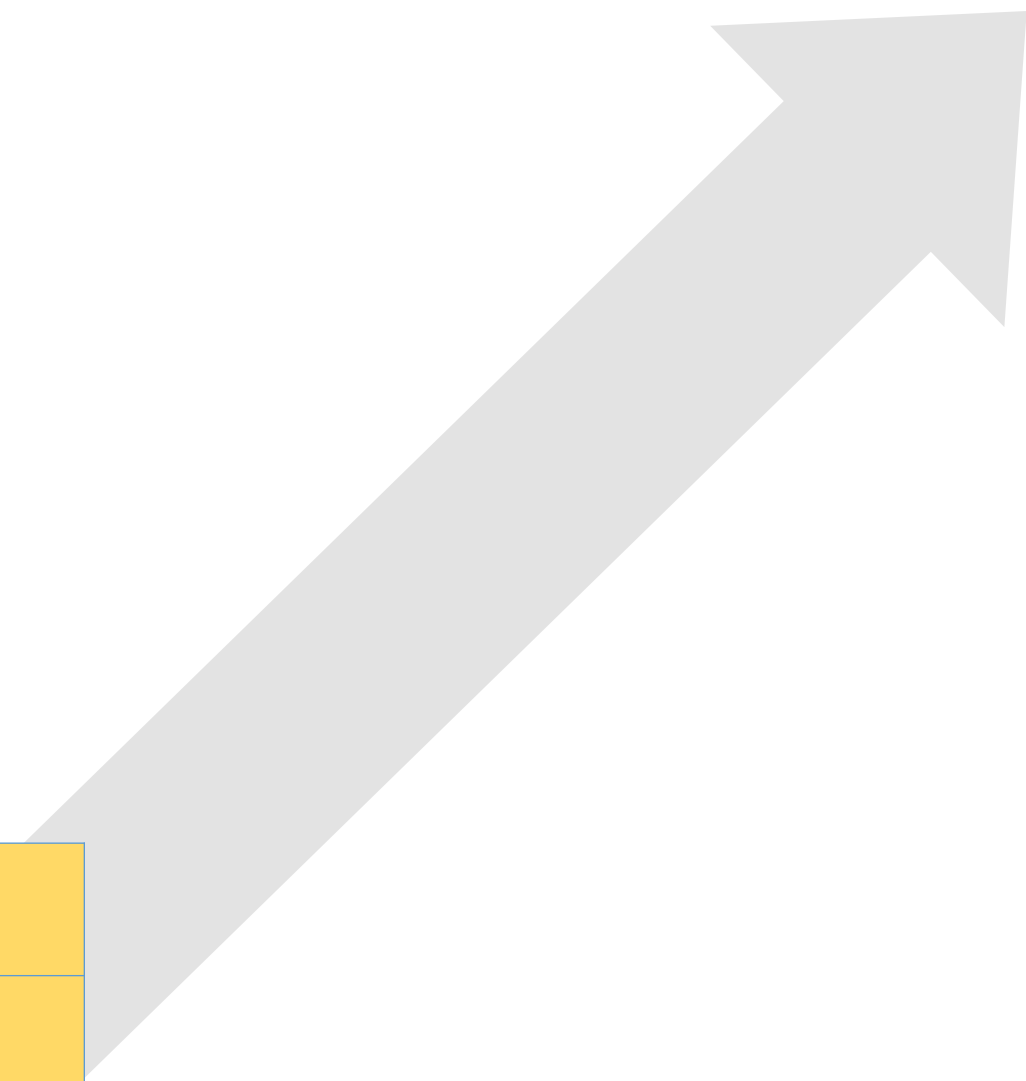

# CREDITS?

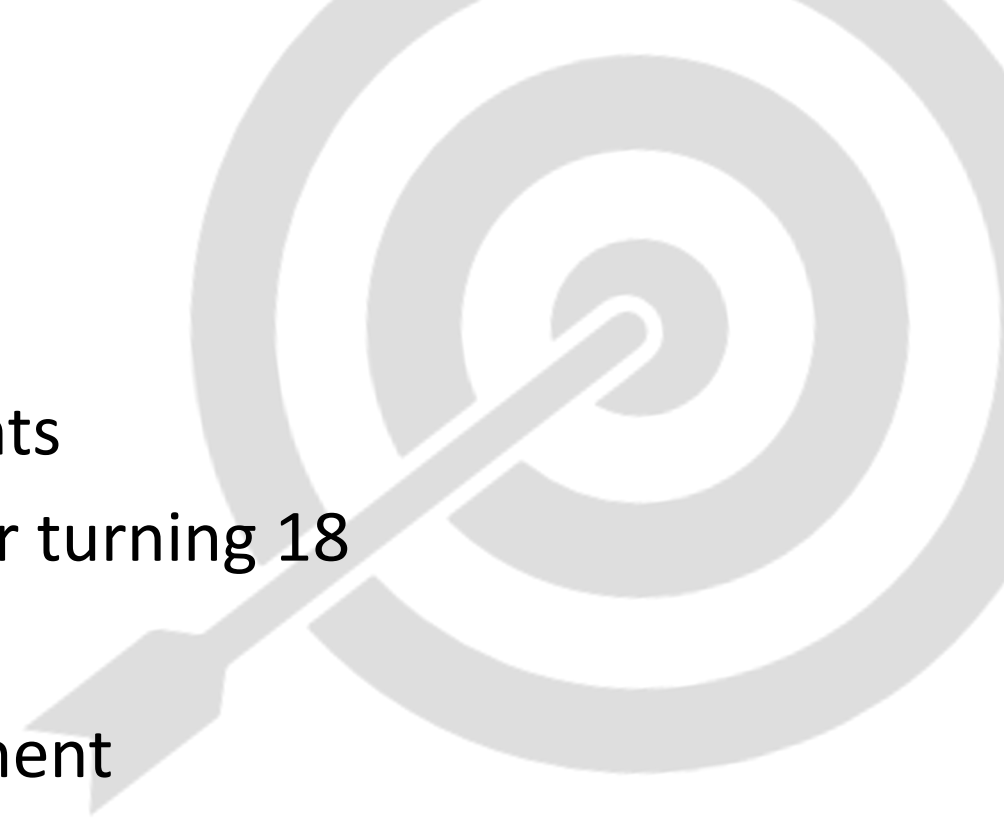
- You need 20 Credits to Graduate

## WHY THIS PLAN?

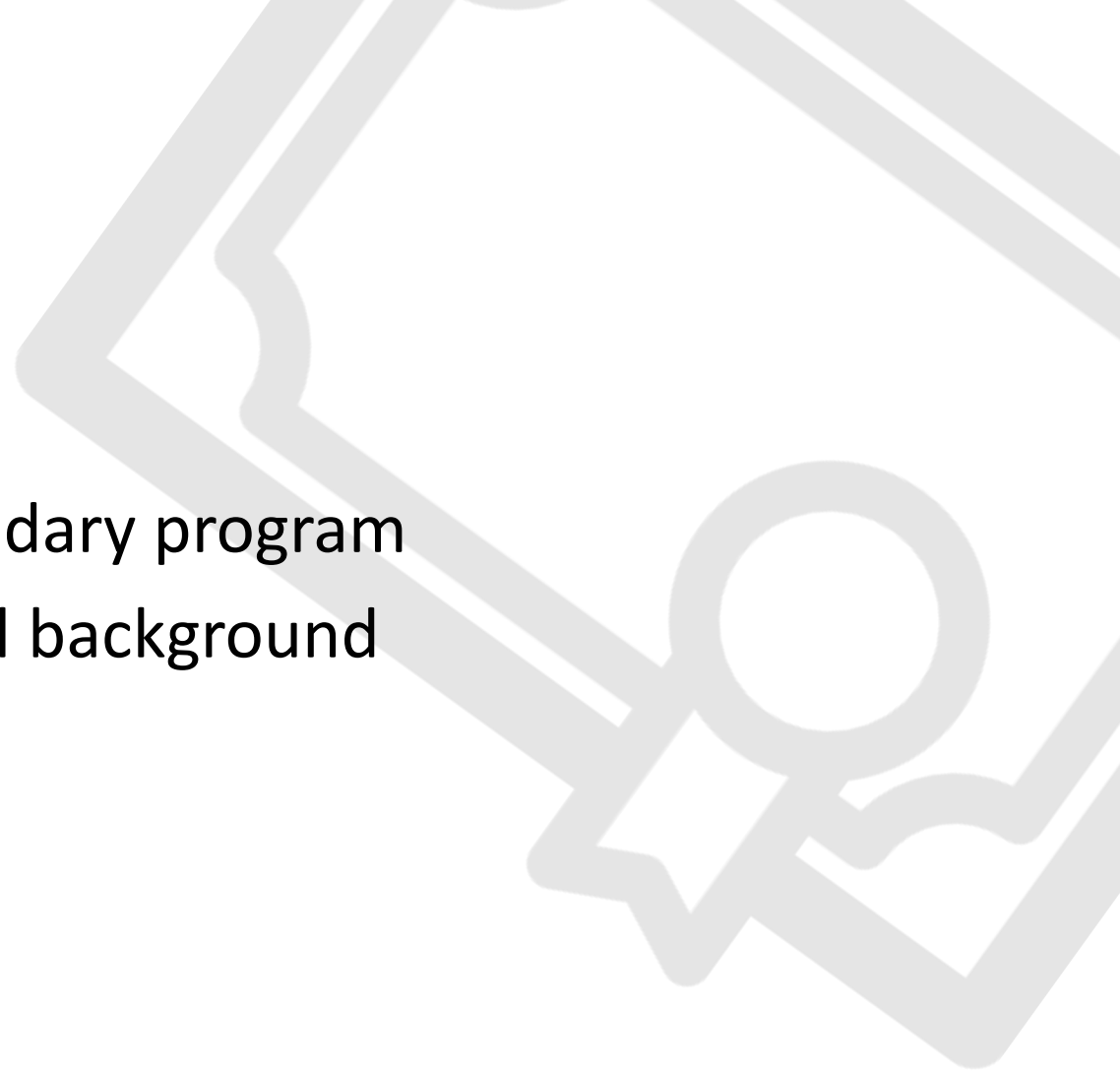
- Cannot meet Regular Dogwood requirements
- Eligibility – have to complete 3 courses after turning 18
- Fewer courses achieved thus far
- Challenges with learning/learning environment
- Unique circumstances

## WHY NOT THIS PLAN?

- You are on-track for regular Dogwood
- You are considering specific Post-Secondary program
- You wish to have a broader educational background
