- Eligibility - have to complete 3 courses after turning 18

## UNIVERSITY ADMISSIONS

1) High school Graduation
2) Apply before the stated deadline
3) Personal Profile
4) GLA 12 Score (UBC Requires a 3)
5) English 12
6) 5+ additional academic courses (variable, but recommended)

- Institution-specific (min grades in certain subjects)
- Program specific (completion of specific 11 and 12 subjects eg. Faculty of Science or Engineering)

7) Competitive G.P.A. (AVERAGE ) based on

- English 12 and other required courses depending on program


## COLLEGE ADMISSIONS

1) High school Graduation
2) English 12
3) Arts \& Science and University Transfer may require specific Grade 11/12 subjects
4) Upgrading options available
5) Apply Early! First Come First Serve

- Some PSI Programs require Precalculus 12, or even Calculus 12 (Ontario, etc)
- Very important to review requirements for PSI programs

- Need ONE Grade 11 Science to Graduate
- Think about your success and struggles in Science 10; choose accordingly
- Think about your Future Goals (You do NOT need to take 3 Grade 11 Sciences)
- Very important to review requirements for PSI programs

## LANGUAGE ARTS REQUIREMENTS

- Require Grade 8-12 Language Arts
- Review PSI requirements - All require English 12, but some degrees of success are required
