APPROVED RESEARCH – AGENDA GAP

Agenda Gap is a youth-led policy advocacy to promote adolescent mental health and advance health equity across socioecological domains. In this study, inviting youth (grades 9-11) and 10 – 15 per group to become collaborators in a group process where they gain mental health promotion knowledge and skills to:

- Identify what impacts youth mental health in their community
- Create strategies and action plans for policy change to improve mental wellbeing

Approximately 45 hours over 6 months is required to participate in this research. Interested youth will receive a \$20 honorarium to acknowledge their time and contribution for an initial interview survey (approximately 60 minutes in duration).
