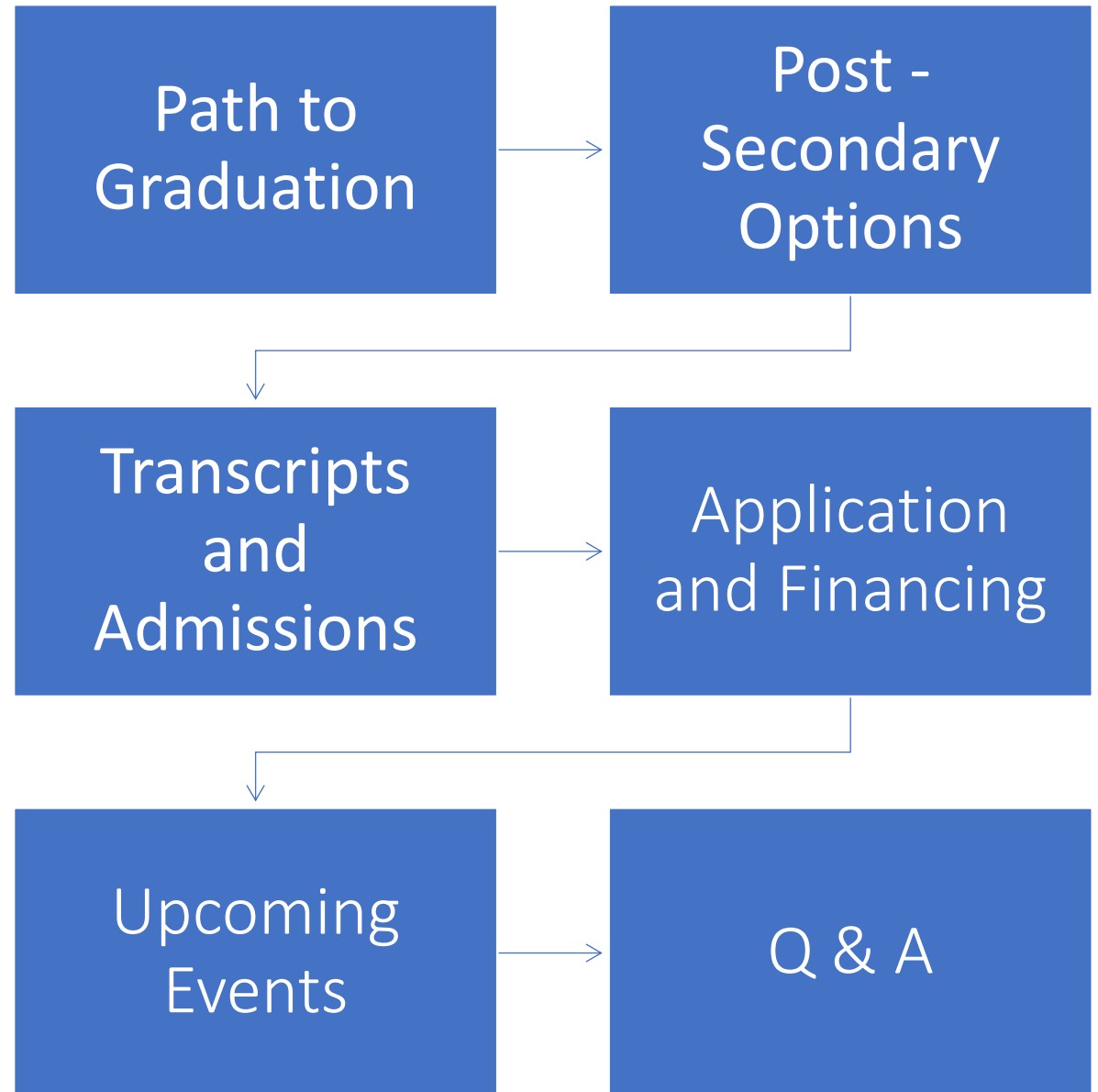

WHAT DOES IT TAKE TO BE OFFERED ADMISSION?

- 
- 1) High school Graduation – General Admission Requirements
  - 2) Personal Profile/Statement, Video Interview/auditions etc.
  - 3) English 12 or English 12 First Peoples (Min. 70%)
  - 4) Language Requirements – Demonstrate English proficiency  
( IELTS, TOEFL, ...)
  - 5) Second Language requirement (UBC/SFU)– Approved language
  - 6) 6 academic courses (Program Specific – eg. Science, Arts....)
  - 7) Grade 11 and 12 courses will be used in the admission evaluation



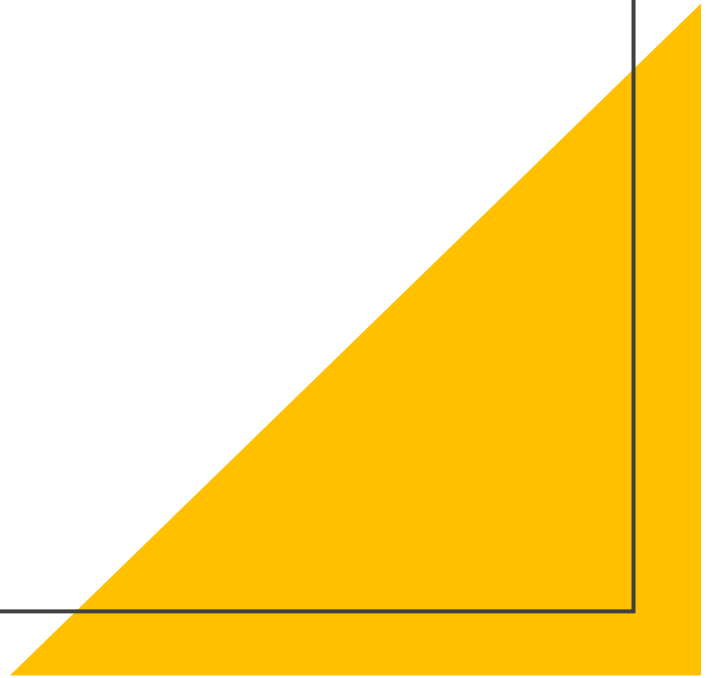

# Post Secondary Application

---

- Create an account – e.g. Educationalplannerbc.com- *name, email, password*
- After creating your personal account...select Post Secondary Institutions
- Begin your application to your selected PSI – Choose program (Faculty), Term-Fall semester
- Pay application fee for each PSI – Credit card
- Submit documents (Grade 11 transcript (grades)) – Create a BCeID - Student transcripts Service (STS) [www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca](http://www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca) – Create account to submit transcripts to chosen PSI – no charge (max.25)

## What you'll need

Before you access the StudentTranscripts Service as a current student, you will need

- Your Personal Education Number (PEN)
  - Check your report card or contact your school to find your PEN. See [Find Your PEN](#)
- A valid email address
- Your date of birth
- Your legal first and last name

You must register for a Basic BCeID account to access the StudentTranscripts Service.

You are a current student if you are presently enrolled in a secondary school or have completed a course within the last six months. If you're not a current student, see [Order Transcripts & Certificates](#).
