



- After creating your personal account...select Post Secondary Institutions
- Begin your application to your selected PSI Choose program (Faculty), Term-Fall semester
- Pay application fee for each PSI Credit card
- Submit documents (Grade 11 transcript (grades)) Create a BCeID -Student transcripts Service (STS) <u>www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca</u> – Create account to submit transcripts to chosen PSI – no charge (max.25)





ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS


- Apply to multiple schools
