2025 YOUTH SURVEY ON VAPING OPEN UNTIL JUNE 10

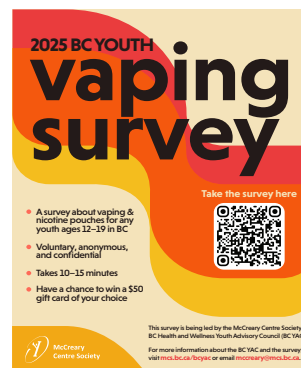
