## 2025 YOUTH SURVEY ON VAPING OPEN UNTIL JUNE 10

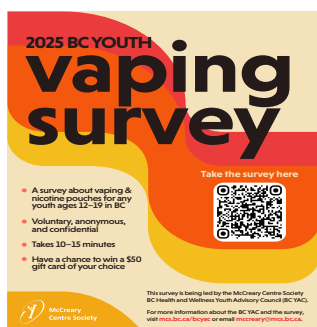
All students in Grades 8-12 are invited to participate in a survey that was developed by youth in Grades 8-12 who are members of the BC Youth Health and Wellness Advisory Council, whose mandate is to advise the Ministries of Health and Education about youth substance use and other health-related topics.

This survey aims to gather youth's views and experiences with vaping and nicotine pouches, as well as their thoughts on how schools and community services can better support them in these areas.

We want to ensure that all young people, whether or not they use these products, have a chance to express their opinions. Here are some key details about the survey:

- Open to all youth aged 12-19 in BC
- Anonymous, confidential, and voluntary
- Takes approximately 10-15 minutes to complete
- Participants can enter to win a \$50 gift card
