This is 48 minutes of dedicated time set aside for students to decide what to do and focus on learning about themselves as a learner. Students will sign up to be with one of their Semester 1 teachers to get additional help, work on projects individually or in a group, or engage in personal activities such as goal setting. Periodically, students will also engage in grade-wide activities such as Program Planning, Core Competencies Reflection and/or Career Education activities.
