# SUMMER LEARNING PROGRAMS (optional)

## Secondary Enrichment Non-Credit Courses

- Will NOT cover the entire course but **review** certain concepts.
- Prepare for next year's courses or this year's courses
- Non-Credit – does not replace taking the course in school
- 2 hours each day throughout July

## Academic Full Credit

- These are for credit and are very rigorous
- Replaces taking the course at school
- 3.5 hours each day; 2-3 hour of daily homework
- July through first week of August

**NOTE:** If you are taking a course over the summer, please tell us which course you are taking in the “Notes for Counsellor” Section on your online planning

Ex. Taking Physics 11 in Summer School, please put me in Physics 12


