All students MUST select a total of **EIGHT (8) core and elective courses**, plus **TWO (2) alternate elective courses**.

Please use your Program Planning Sheet as a guide for selecting courses.

- Career Life Connections 12 is taken as a 9th course to be completed off-schedule. All students must register for this course through RVS. Successful completion of CLC 12 is required to graduate.
