SUMMER LEARNING PROGRAMS (optional)

- **Secondary Enrichment Non-Credit Courses**
 - Will NOT cover the entire course but **review** certain concepts.
 - Prepare for next year's courses or review this year's courses
 - Non-Credit so it does not replace taking the course in school
 - 2 hours each day throughout July



Next Year's Grade 9's: Course Selection Options

Grade 8 students, it's time to select your Grade 9 courses for the 2026-2027 school year!

All students **MUST** select a total of **EIGHT (8) core and elective courses**, plus **TWO (2) alternate elective courses**.

Please use your Program Planning Sheet as a guide for selecting courses.

Required Courses

Grade 9 students must select a course package containing their core courses.

ELL students will have a different package depending on their level.

1. MEN--09: English 9
2. MMA--09: Math 9
3. MSS--09: Social Studies 9
4. MSC--09: Science 9
5. Physical and Health Education 9 (SELECT ONE):
 - MPHE-09: Physical and Health Education 9
 - MPHE-09--SC: Strength and Conditioning 9

Elective Courses

Grade 9 students must select 1 Arts Education elective and 1 Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies (ADST) elective.

Please also select 2 alternate electives.

6. Elective: Arts Education
7. Elective: Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies
8. Elective: Second Language is recommended for most students

Ensure that you select all the core courses required for graduation and take the time to consider elective courses based on your interests, personal strengths and post-secondary plans. Please contact your counsellor if you have any questions about the course selection process: Mr. Lam (A-L), and Mr. McDonnell (M-Z).

Note: Study blocks are not available for Grade 9 students.
