### Last Few Weeks and Learning Completion

Teachers are available for Learning Completion Days in the final week of June (June 22-24). In cases where this time is needed, students should plan ahead with their teachers so that all can be prepared to use this time efficiently.

### Notice of Late Return – 2026/2027 School Year

Please fill the [Notice of Late Return 2026-2027](#) form if your child(ren) will return to **school later than 12:00pm Wednesday, Sept. 9, 2026 and on or before Sept 11, 2026**. Please complete this form and return to the school principal **before June 24, 2026**.

If a student is not returning on or before September 11, 2026, a school cannot reserve a spot guaranteeing the ability to be enrolled in the school. There may be a need for a placement at another school upon the student’s late return.

Staff from Vancouver Coastal Health will be onsite to provide immunizations to students who have missed previous immunization days. If you have received an e-consent letter, please complete this and submit it to the school office prior to the immunization clinic date
