PLT Introduction
This year again, PLT will fall during second block of the day. Weekly Personal Learning Time (PLT) will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays at Boyd, from 9:41 – 10:41am . This is 60 minutes of dedicated time set aside for students to decide what to do and focus on learning about themselves as a learner. Students will sign up to be with one of their Semester 1 teachers to get additional help, work on projects individually or in a group, or engage in personal activities such as goal setting. Periodically, students will also engage in grade-wide activities such as Program Planning, Core Competencies Reflection and/or Career Education activities.
PLT is centered around three Guiding Principles:
a) PLT empowers students to take ownership of their learning by allowing them to focus on their specific needs b) PLT will offer choice to support learners to be independent learners c) PLT will focus on the development of goals and will be tied to the Core Competencies – Communication, Thinking, Personal and Social Responsibility
Meeting for Potential Clubs

If students are interested in leading a club, we ask them to confirm a teacher sponsor and attend this mandatory meeting to outline the expectations and process required this year for all club applications.
