National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

On Tuesday, September 29, all students will be participating in activities to recognize the importance of the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. Students will be reminded of the significance of Orange Shirt Day, and consider acts of reconciliation as a school community.

PLT Official Start: October 1

On Thursday, October 1, students will have their first independent PLT session. Grade 8-10 students will sign up in advance for a PLT session with one of their four first semester teachers. Grades 11 and 12 students will may also sign up with first semester teachers, library or lounge. Students must stay in their chosen PLT location for the entire 60-minute PLT period. Students are also reminded that personal digital devices may only be used for educational purposes during PLT.

Sign up sheets for teachers will be posted on classroom doors. Students are encouraged to plan ahead and sign up early to ensure a spot in the classroom of their choice.

Student Organization – Planning for Success
