The Student Learning Survey (SLS) has been administered every year in B.C. public schools since 2001. Prior to 2016-2017 it was known as the Student Satisfaction Survey. The SLS provides feedback on the implementation of the curriculum changes, learning environment, student wellness and satisfaction, student belonging and engagement, and career preparation. Schools and districts use the SLS to make informed decisions around long-term planning and goal-setting, and in providing individual students personalized support.
